JUDGE SHALL GIVE WEIGHT TO ANY EVEN PACE, MANNERS, WAY OF GOING and STYLE OF JUMPING. TICKS SHALL NOT BE SCORED UNLESS THE FAULT OF BAD JUMPING, CONFORMATION SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED. Horses and ponies to be hunting sound.

THE COMMITTEE URGES THAT FORMAL HUNTING ATTIRE BE WORN FOR ALL CLASSES AND DIVISIONS. HOWEVER, FORMAL HUNTING ATTIRE IS ONLY MANDATORY IN THE SENIOR FOXHUNTER DIVISION.

ENTRY FEE - \$25 PER CLASS / NO HORSE MAY ENTER THE SAME CLASS TWICE

EXHIBITORS IN ALL DIVISIONS MAY ENTER PAIRS AND TEAMS OF THREE.

OPEN SCHOOLING

CLASS 1: SCHOOLING 2'6"
CLASS 2: SCHOOLING 3' - 3'3"

VERY GREEN DIVISION

CLASS 3-4: FIELD COURSE JUMPS NOT TO EXCEED 2'6"
CLASS 5: VERY GREEN UNDER SADDLE

VERY GREEN DIVISION CHAMPION - Awarded to the horse accumulating the most points.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISION

HORSES and PONIES: Open to all riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Mount and rider need not to have hunted. Full points in all classes. JUMPS NOT TO EXCEED 2'6"

CLASSES 6-7: CHILDREN'S OVER FENCES
8: CHILDREN'S UNDER SADDLE

THE MARGARET C. & WILLIAM W. WILLIAMS MEMORIAL TROPHY

CHILDREN'S CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY - Awarded to horse or pony acquiring the most points.

CLASS 9: CHILDREN FOLLOW THE FIELD MASTER

OPEN HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all riders Mount and rider need not to have hunted. JUMPS NOT TO EXCEED 3'3"

CLASSES 10-11: HUNTER OVER FENCES
Judged by style and way of going over a cross country course.

CLASS 12: HUNTER UNDER SADDLE
Judged by style and way of going on the flat.

OPEN HUNTER DIVISION CHAMPION - Awarded to the horse accumulating the most points.

SENIOR FOX HUNTER DIVISION

SENIOR SUBSCRIBERS ONLY - PAST OR PRESENT, HORSE TO HAVE HUNTED A MINIMUM OF 4 TIMES - FORMAL HUNTING ATTIRE. PROFESSIONALS MAY NOT RIDE IN THIS DIVISION UNLESS THEY ARE A CURRENT INDIVIDUAL SUBSCRIBER. JUMPS NOT TO EXCEED 3'

CLASS 13: HUNTER OVER FENCES - THE MASTER'S TROPHY - To be ridden by a Senior rider who has hunted regularly with a recognized or registered pack of hounds. To be ridden in formal hunting attire. To be judged on performance, manners, way of going, and completion of tasks typically encountered in our hunting field

Bonus may be earned by cracking a whip at end of the round

CLASS 14: FOLLOW THE FIELD MASTER - THE RICHARD OF LIMERICK TROPHY
To be ridden by a rider 18 and over who has hunted a horse that has been ridden with a recognized or registered pack of hounds. Rider and horse to have hunted a minimum of 4 times. All horses to follow the field master.

CLASS 15: FOLLOW THE FIELD MASTER FOR HILLTOPPERS - THE POTEEN TROPHY
To be ridden by a rider 18 and over who has hunted a horse that has been ridden with a recognized or registered pack of hounds. Rider and horse to have hunted a minimum of 4 times. All horses to follow the field master. NO JUMPS.

SENIOR FOX HUNTING CHAMPIONSHIP - THE BAKER'S DOZEN TROPHY
Awarded to the horse accumulating the most points.

PAIRS - TEAMS

OPEN TO ALL: One professional per pair or teams - No points.

CLASS 16: OPEN PAIRS - THE LEONARD SOGG MEMORIAL TROPHY
At least one fence abreast. Performance to count 75%; substance, quality and similarity of pairs 25%. Open to any pair.

CLASS 17: TEAMS OF THREE - THE ANDREW K. CHERNA MEMORIAL TROPHY
Open to any team. Performance only to count. At least one fence abreast.

A perpetual trophy for Children Riders. Trophy to remain at the Clubhouse.

THE RICHARD OF LIMERICK TROPHY

A permanent trophy for the best field hunter performance in memory of Richard. Trophy to remain at the Clubhouse.

THE POTEEN TROPHY

A permanent trophy for the best hilltopping field hunter performance. Trophy to remain at the Clubhouse.

THE MASTERS' TROPHY

Presented by the Masters of The Chagrin Valley Hunt. This silver tray is a permanent trophy to remain at the Clubhouse.

THE PETER S. HITCHCOCK MEMORIAL TROPHY

Given in memory of Mr. Hitchcock by the 2017 Hunter Trials Committee. Trophy to be kept in the Clubhouse.

THE BAKER'S DOZEN TROPHY

Presented to the Champion Field Hunter. To be won three times by the same exhibitor for permanent possession. Trophy to remain at the Clubhouse.

THE LEONARD SOGG MEMORIAL TROPHY

Presented by the family of Mr. Leonard Sogg, Ex-MFH in his memory. A perpetual trophy for pairs of field hunters. Trophy to be property of The Chagrin Valley Hunt Club and remain at Clubhouse.

THE ANDREW K. CHERNA MEMORIAL TROPHY

Given in memory of Mr. Cherna by the 2017 Hunter Trials Committee. Trophy to be kept in the Clubhouse.
